

**Statement from Wynn Resorts regarding the conclusion of the IEB presentation of their report before the Massachusetts Gaming Commission**

The presentation by the IEB provided a detailed and thorough review of the findings of its report to the Massachusetts Gaming Commission. The findings are consistent with the investigation conducted by our own Special Committee of Independent Directors as well as that of the Nevada Gaming Control Board. The Company does not contest the facts contained in the IEB's report.

Since initial allegations against company founder Steve Wynn were made public in January 2018, Wynn Resorts has taken swift and decisive action as well as engaged in a period of intense self-reflection and outside review. Wynn Resorts has made countless changes throughout the organization, including a refresh of our Board of Directors; executive leadership changes; a wholesale update to our policies for identifying, reporting and addressing reports of sexual harassment or assault; enhanced training initiatives; and a renewed focus on creating a diverse, inclusive and respectful workplace culture.

Any employee who was aware of allegations of sexual assault against the Company's founder and did not investigate or report is no longer with the Company.

Our Board and management plan to share more detail on all of these actions and initiatives during our presentation.
